Despite increasing voluntary corporate pledges and regulatory pressure, over 350 million tonnes of plastic waste is generated each year. Only 9% of this is being recycled.

The Global Plastic Treaty acknowledges that a variety of solutions will be needed across the entire life cycle of plastics to address plastic pollution.
