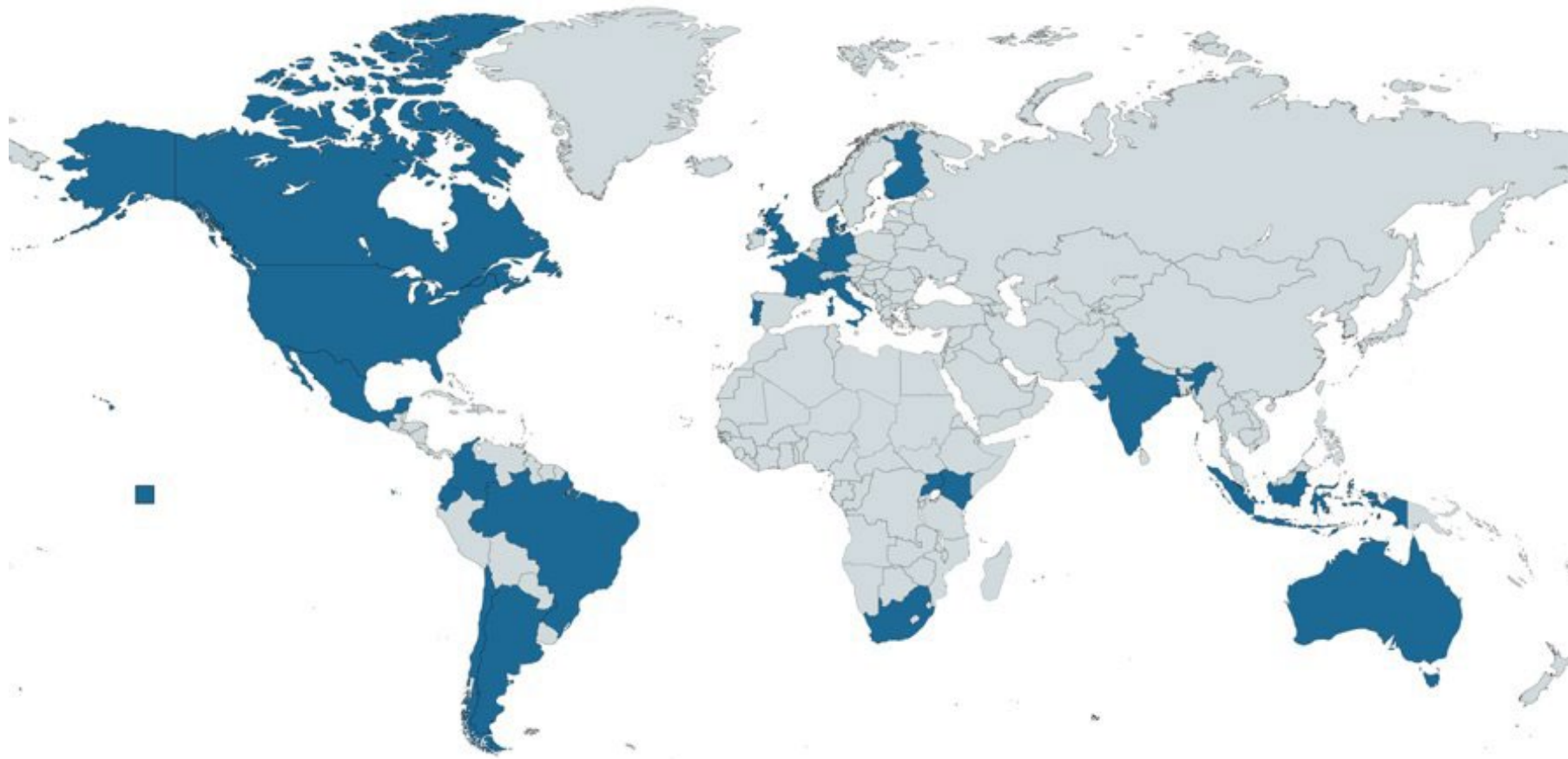

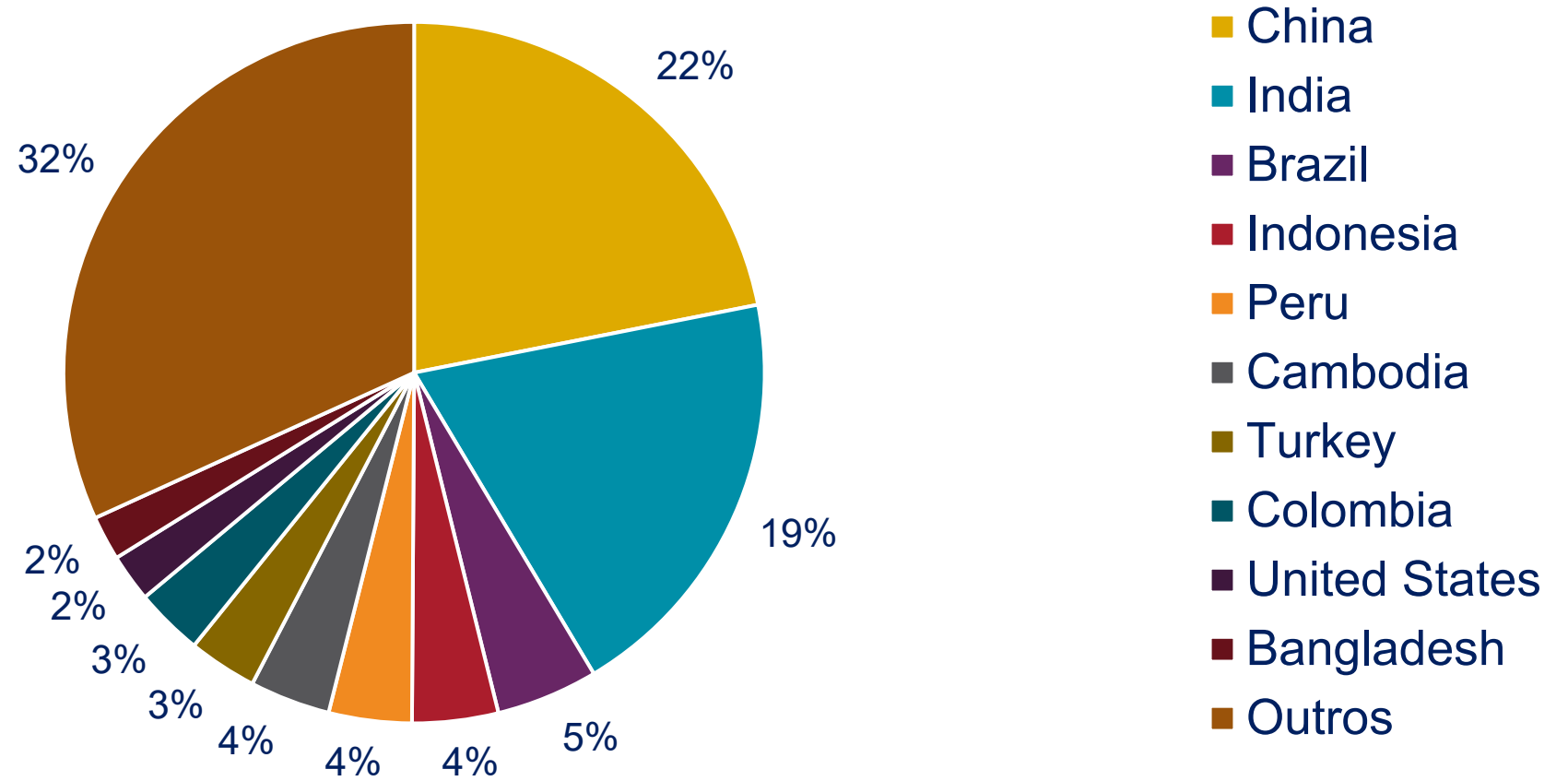

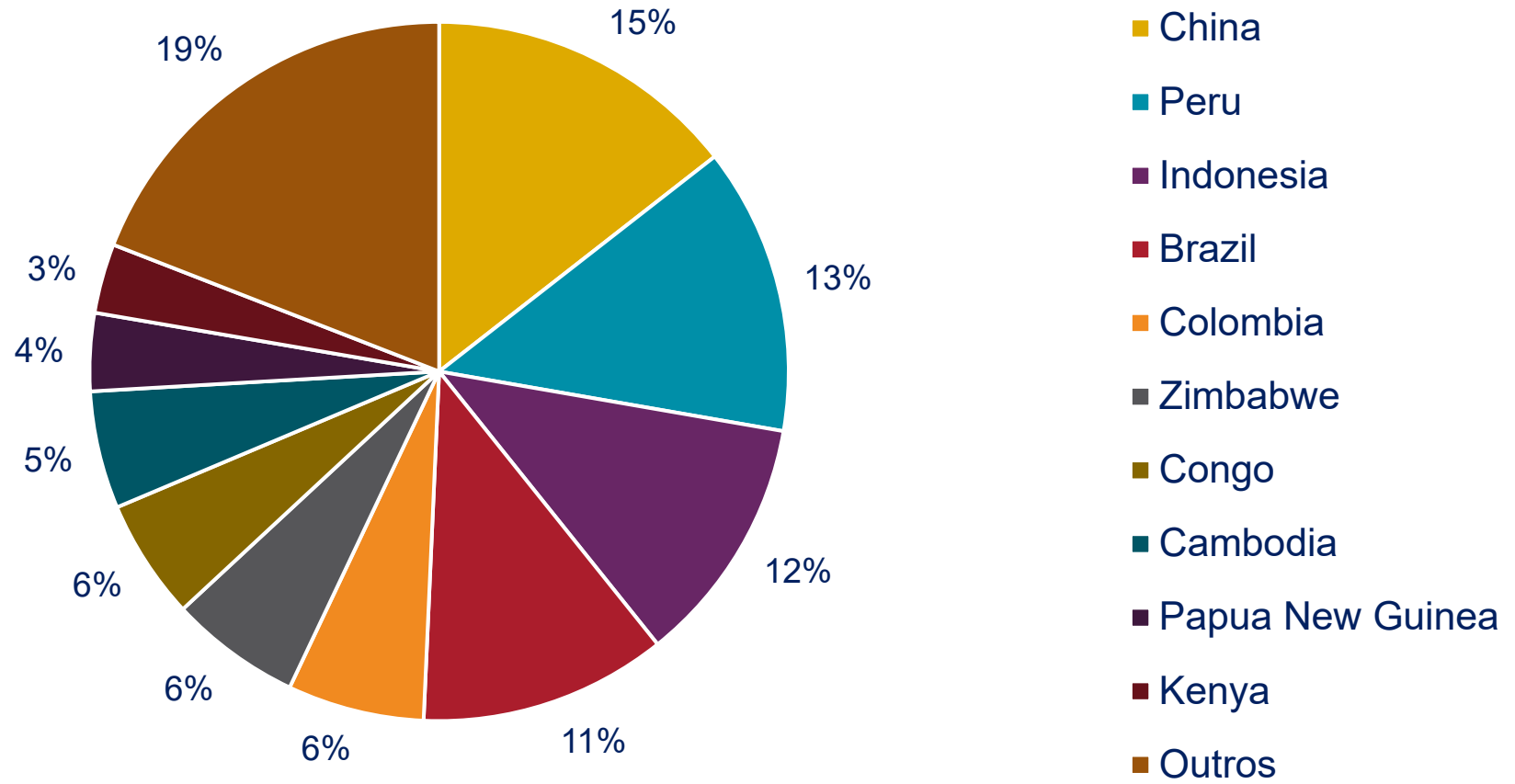

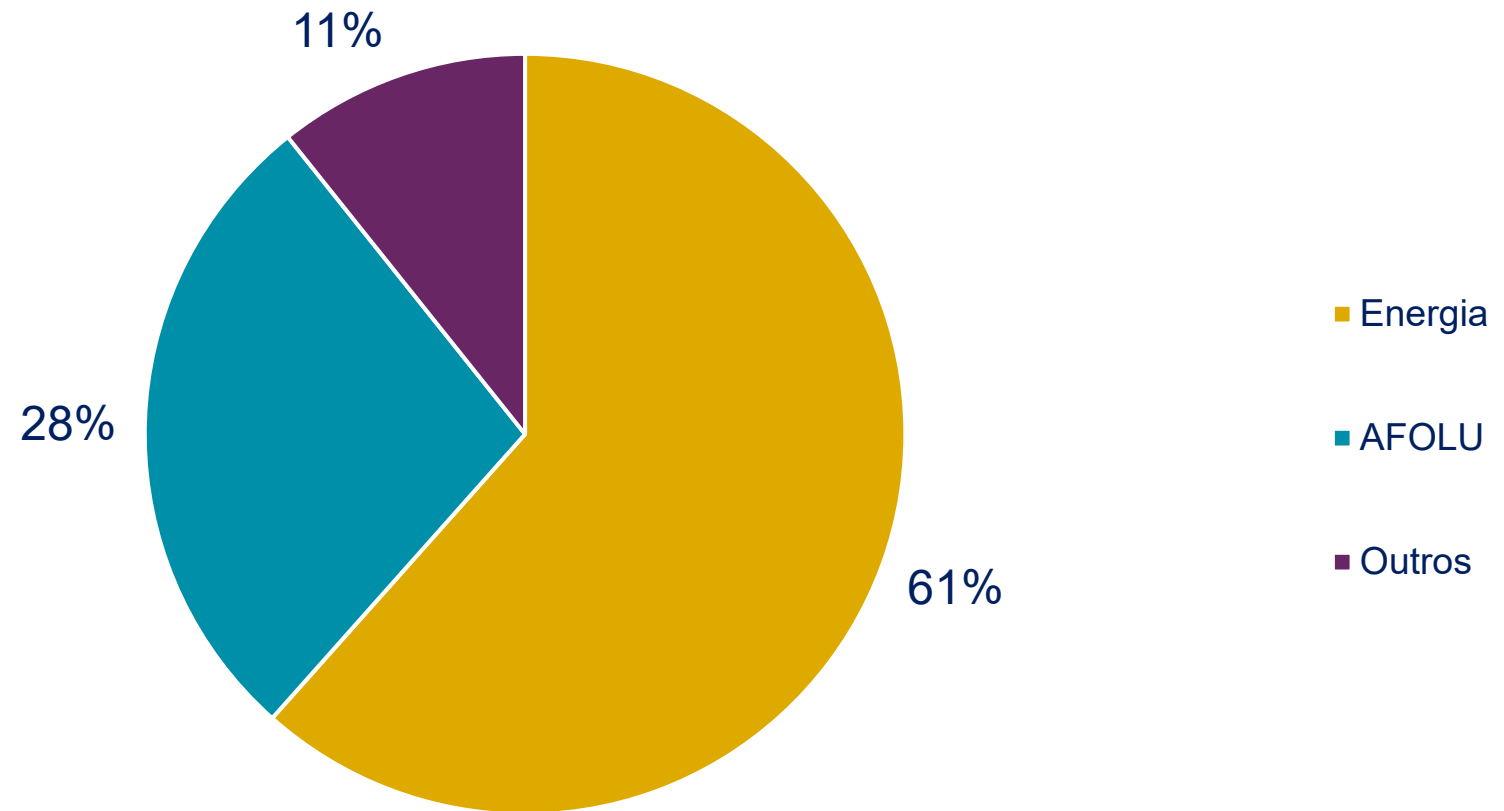
Top 10, VCU's Emissions



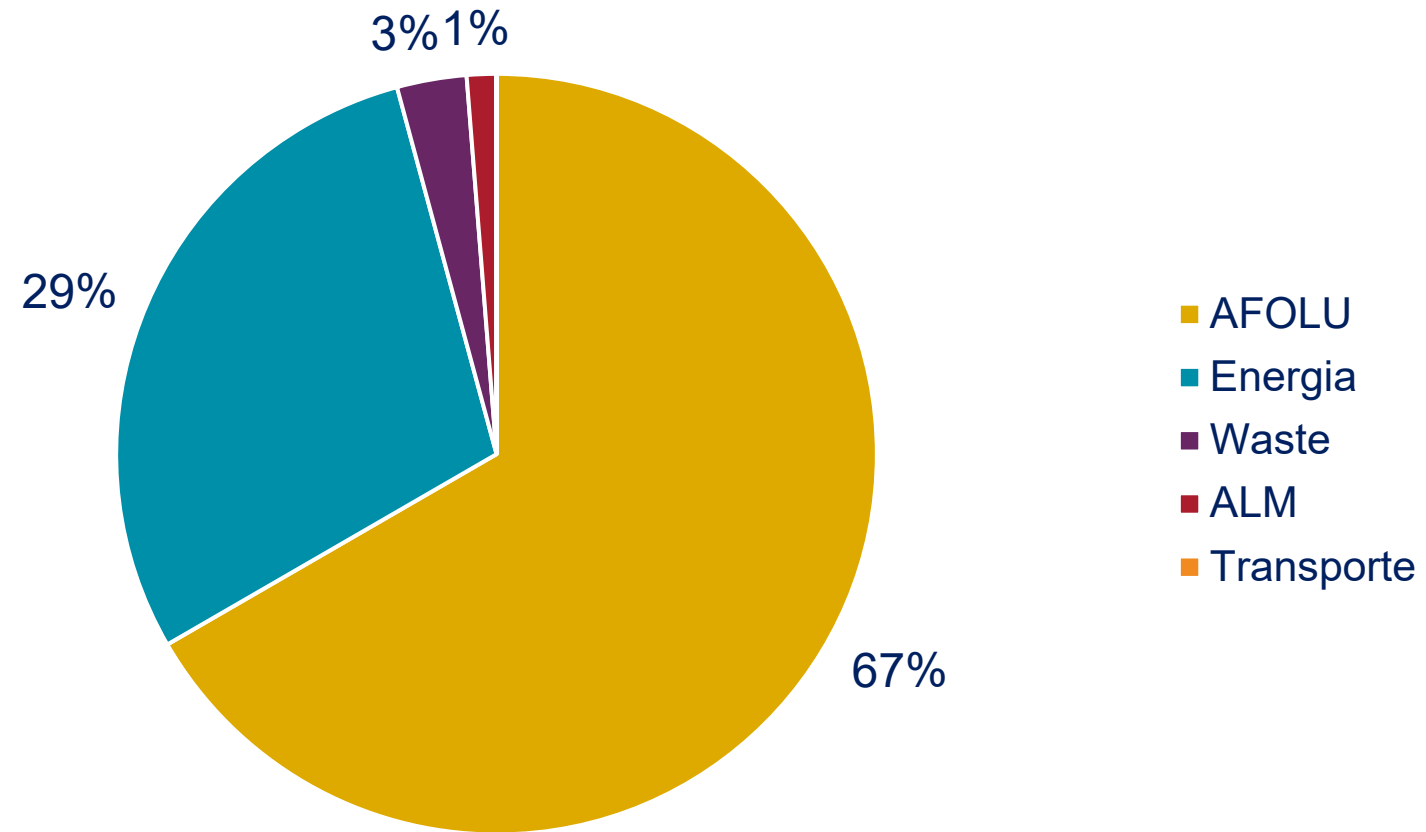
Top 10, NBS Projects



Project Types World

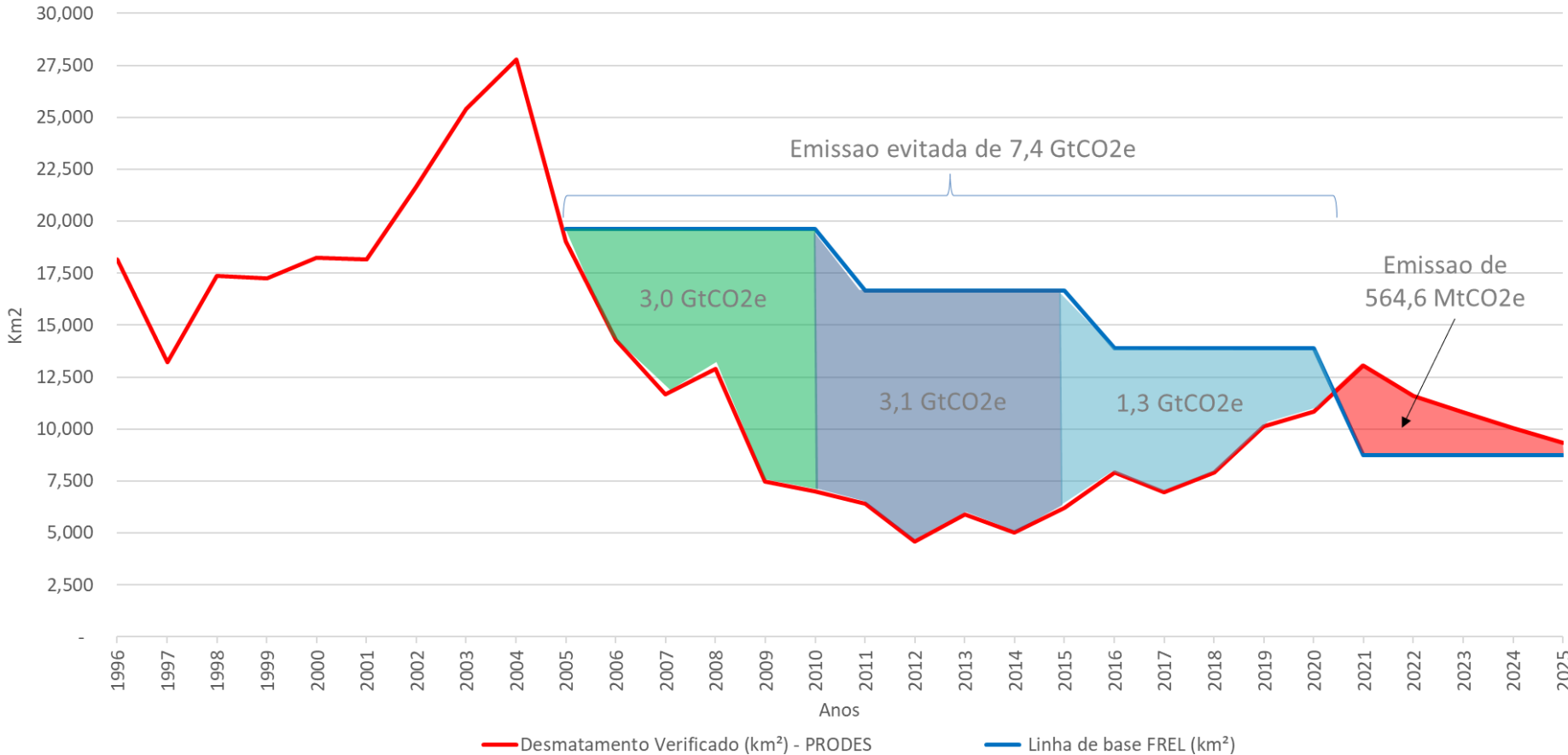


VCUs per Project Type in Brazil

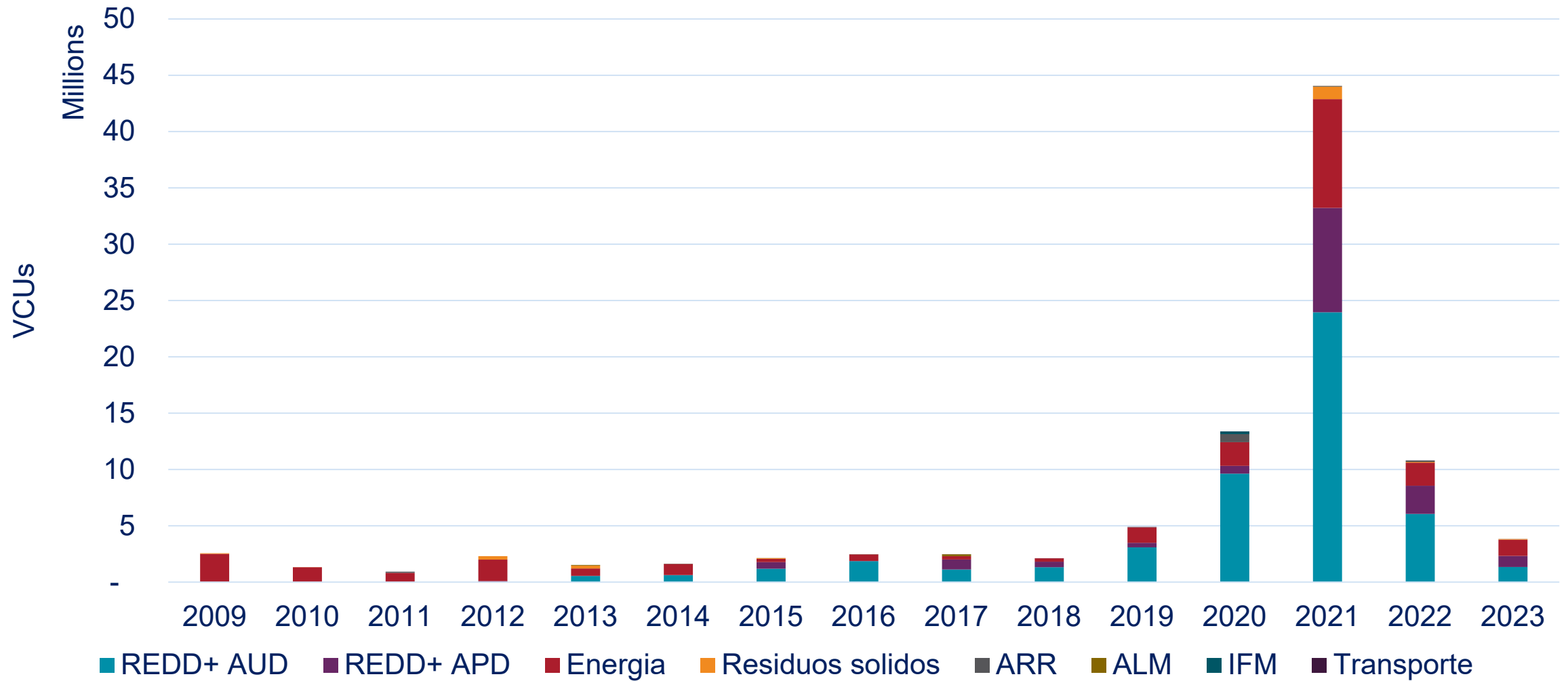


Brazilian FREL and ERs

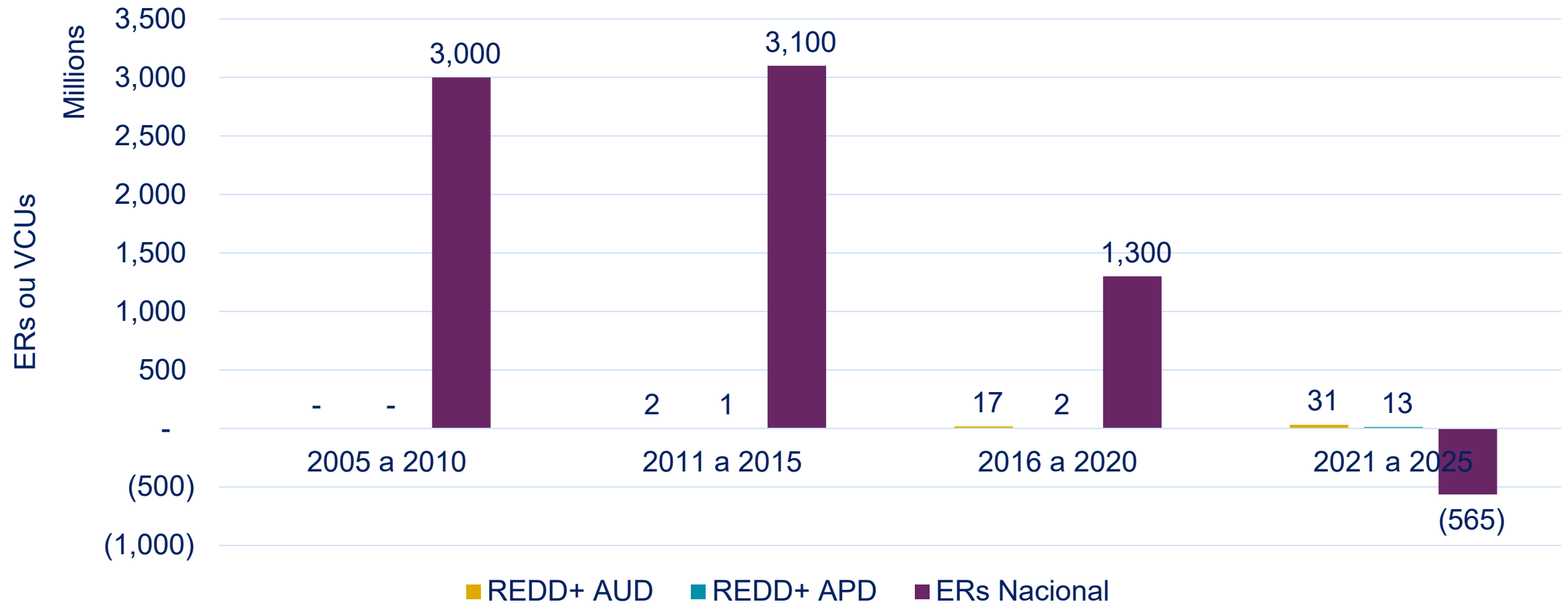
Potencial de Geracao de ERs a partir da Reducao do Desmatamento na Amazonia



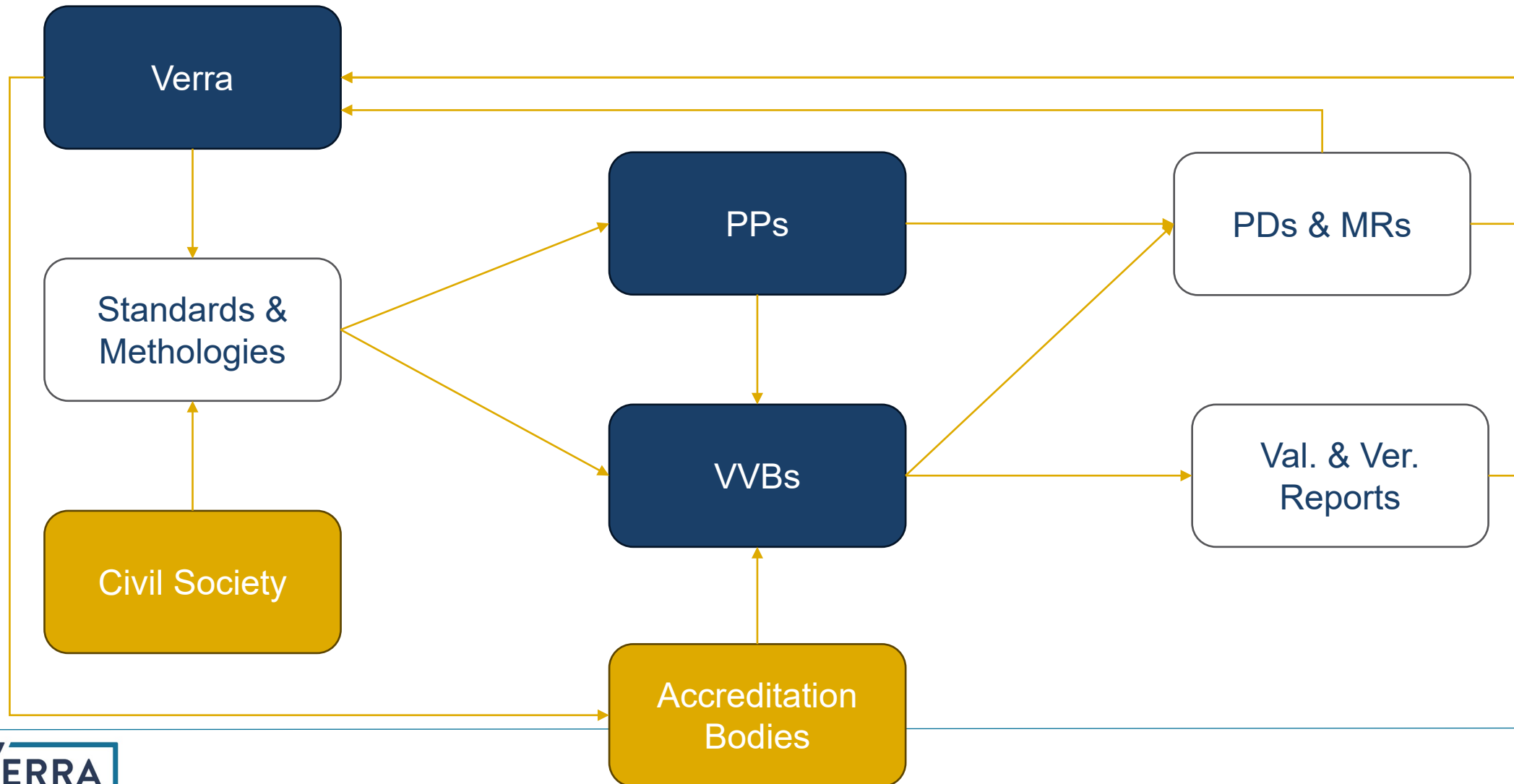
VCUs Emissions in Brazil



ERs x VCUs in Brasil



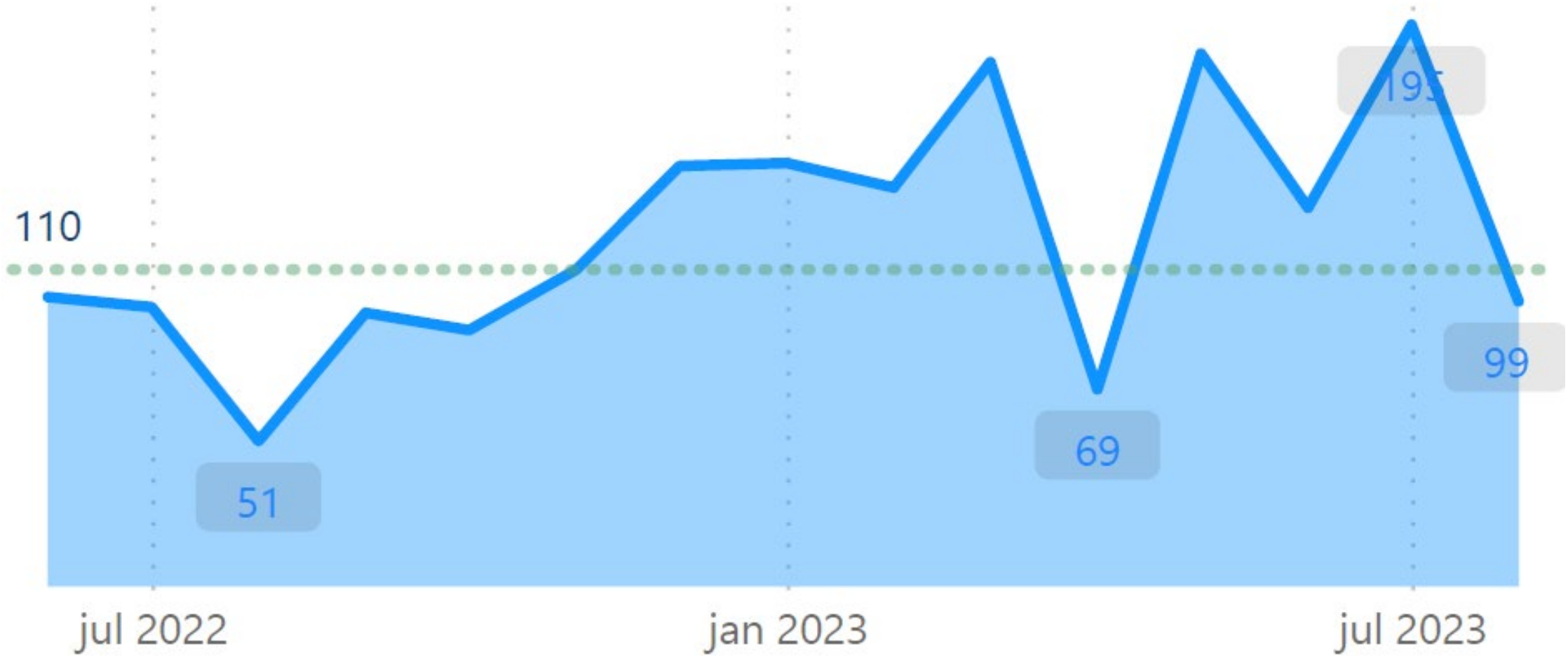

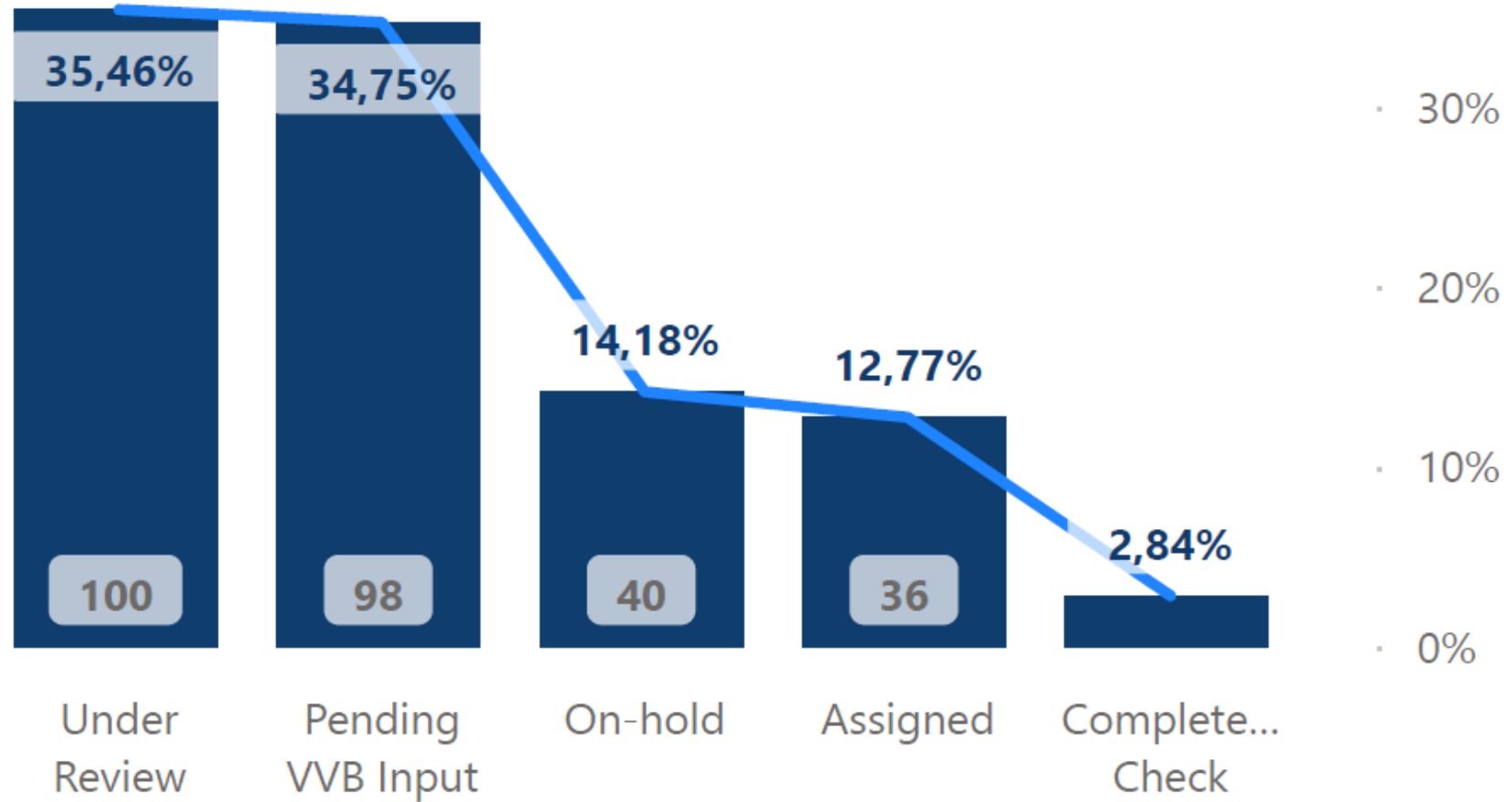
Challenges & Strategic Actions

New REDD+ Methodology (M0184)

- It will be released by September 2023.
- Mandatory for AUD Projects, with a grace period (6 months).
- Verra will handle the modeling, calculate baselines (spatial component) and allocation to Projects.
- DSPs will provide deforestation data and risk maps. Information exchange and state validation will be required to ensure accounting accuracy and system integrity.



New REDD+ Methodology (M0184)

- The methodology becomes mandatory for Projects in the pipeline after the end of the grace period.
- Projects “under validation” before the end of the grace period can proceed using old methodologies but must complete validation within 1 year after the start of public comments period.
- The methodology becomes mandatory for registered Projects that initiate verification after the end of the grace period.
